

Planning Commission Ordinance

Number: 2024-1

Section I: Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to add alternates to the Planning Commission membership. The Planning Commission was established through Section 2.0500 of the Town of Franklin General Code of Ordinances.

Section II: Authority

The Town Board of the Town of Franklin has been authorized to exercise village powers pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 60.10(2)(c) and 60.22(3). The Town Board adopts this ordinance under its general village powers authority and Wis. Stat. § 66.1014.

Section III: Definitions

“Plan Commission” Consists of five (5) citizen members who are residents of the Town and who shall be persons of recognized experience and qualifications. However, one (1) Town Board member may be appointed if only four (4) citizen members are appointed.

Section IV: Alternate Members

- A) Two (2) alternate members shall be appointed by the Town Chairperson for a term of three (3) years. The first alternate shall act with full power, only when a member of the Plan Commission refuses to vote because of conflict of potential conflict of interest or when a member is absent. The second alternate shall act only when the first alternate so refuses or is absent or when more than one member of the Plan Commission so refuses or is absent. All Plan Commission members shall reside in the Town of Franklin.

Section V: Effective Date and Publication


This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication as required under Wis. Stat. § 60.80.
