

February 9, 2026 MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING FOR TOWN OF FRANKLIN

The February monthly meeting for the Town of Franklin was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Wesely following the Pledge of Allegiance.

Officers present: Dave Wesely, Katie Duckart, Dusty Smidle, Sandy Smidle, & Suzi Sevcik

Supervisor Duckart moved to approve the agenda. Supervisor Smidle seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Supervisor Duckart moved to accept the minutes from the January Town Board meeting. Supervisor Smidle seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Treasurer's Report, which shows a balance of \$1,053,130.65

Zoning administrator Suzi Sevcik noted there were no building permits issued.

Scott Browne, County Supervisor, was not present.

EMR – There were 15 call last month.

Quarry update – Derek Taushek was present, talked about pumping excess water to the north vs. the south. There were concerns about mining too close to the property line on the north, and if they carried pollution liability insurance. No action was taken as the Town's attorney was not present.

Written decision for Parallel 44 was tabled as the town attorney was not present & didn't send over the paperwork.

A request was made by UWGB **Waterway Marker Permit** for installation of a research buoy and monitoring station on **Shea Lake** to collect continuous, high-frequency water temperature and dissolved oxygen data over the next five years (at least), beginning at ice-out this coming spring. Chairman Wesely moved to approve the permit, Supervisor Smidle seconded the motion, motion carried.

Engledinger Lane Request was reviewed, but Nathan Sekora was not present so it was tabled.

Citation Ordinance Review – Clerk Sevcik will send out a few before the next meeting to review.

AgRIP – 2<sup>nd</sup> round opening mid April.

Town Disbursements were discussed, approved and paid.
