Quarry update – Violation of CUP to LKB Materials was discussed for the following violations:

- Excavation within 100' of property line
- Excessive mining depth past 774 feet
- Failure to maintain required 3:1 ration quarry side slopes
- Unauthorized processing activities

Approval of minutes of the Written decision for Parallel 44 Rezone. Chairman Wesely moved to approve the minutes of the special meeting for the written decision for Parallel 44 Rezone, Supervisor Duckart seconded the motion, motion carried.
